CERTIFICATE OF COMPLIANCE

With EU Reach Directive 1907/2006/EC

It has been determined that the products we offer are classified as articles by this regulation (European Community Regulation, 1907/2006/EC). As defined by Reach an article is a finished product that "during production is given a special shape, surface, or design which determines its function to a greater degree than its chemical composition". In general an article is an object composed of one or more substances or preparations given a special shape, surface or design. Furthermore an article is understood to be as produced or imported. None of our products contain any "substances of intended release". Typically our products do not release any substances into the environment. As far as we know none of the substances that are components or raw materials used in our products are subject to registration.

We acknowledge our responsibility as an "actor" in the supply chain to provide information on the composition of articles we supply to you (article 33) including confirming the absence or presence of any SVHC (Substance of Very High Concern) when they are present in amounts in excess of 0,1% weight by weight. At present none of the items we supply to you contain any SVHC per the candidate list of June 15, 2015 (163 substances) or Annex 14 in concentrations above 0,1% weight by weight.

We collected information from our suppliers to ensure compliance to the latest requirements. While Reach does not require a full content disclosure, this certificate states the compliance for all our products against the EU Directive 1907/2006/EC.

It is our intention to continue to comply with the spirit of the Reach Directive as well as the letter of law.
